We are happy to say the San Pasqual Environmental Department has had successful start to the New Year with two very productive clean up projects around the reservation, totaling over 40 tons of waste removed. The first project being the San Pasqual Clean Up Event in which we placed 40 yard trash bins in three different locations around the reservation for community use. Thanks to communities participation we filled Eleven 40 yard trash bins with waste and debris that originated from homes all around the reservation.

In addition to the San Pasqual Clean Up Event the Environmental Department worked in collaboration with the Public Works Department and Reliable Tires a certified waste hauler to remove 364 vehicle tires and 81 rims from an illegal dumpsite off of Duro Road. This is the third major clean up of an illegal dump site discovered off of Duro Road, all of which seem to be products of illegal waste haulers. Sites such as these pose many environmental health and safety risks due to stagnant water collecting, rodent infestation and the exposure of sharp or jagged objects.

The best part yet is were not even done yet, the Environmental Department is working on removing Hazardous waste containers from multiple locations around the reservation and San Pasqual Fee land.
