- **VEHICLE OVER HEATING - IT'S POSSIBLE ANY CAR TO OVER HEAT SO IT'S BEST TO BE PREPARED, SOME HELP TIPS:**



KNOW THE SIGNS

- WARNING LIGHTS "CHECK ENGINE/TEMPERATURE"
- STEAM COMING FROM THE HOOD
- ENGINE SMELLING STRANGE/SWEET
- THE TEMPERATURE GAUGE NEEDLE ON HOT/HIGH

WHAT TO DO OR NOT DO IF YOUR CAR OVER HEATS

- TURN OFF AIR CONDITIONER IMMEDIATELY TO REDUCE ENGINE STRESS
- TURN ON THE HEAT, TO HELP DIVERT THE HEAT AWAY FROM THE ENGINE
- FIND A SAFE PLACE TO PULL OVER & SHUT OFF THE ENGINE
- PLEASE DON'T KEEP DRIVING, YOU PUT YOURSELF AT ENGINE AT RISK
- DON'T OPEN THE HOOD RIGHT AWAY LET IT COOL TO AVOID BURNS
- LET ENGINE COOL FOR AT LEAST 15 MINUTES, CHECK TEMP. IF POSSIBLE
- IF POSSIBLE ADD RADIATOR FLUID, TO PROTECT FROM FURTHER DAMAGE
- BEST TO GET IT TOWED BUT IF TOWING IS NOT AN OPTION SLOWLY AND SAFELY GET TO A REPAIR SHOP.

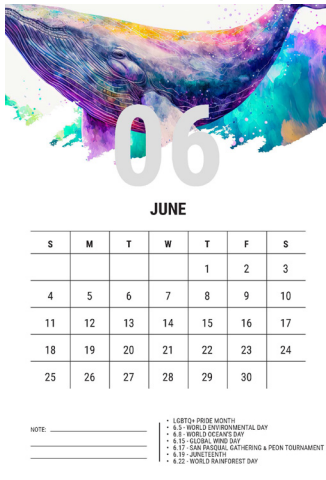
