The 2024 Earth Day brought together over 200 San Pasqual tribal community members, tribal youth and environmental professionals from agencies all over San Diego for a day of fun and education. The day consisted of environmental education which highlighted the importance of pollinators, planting and restoration of the education center creek bed, youth activities, food and music.

Environmental professionals provided youth with fun activities such as coloring and activity books, life size board games, seed balls, acorn necklaces, environmental crafts, solar cars, crafts and much more as a fun Friday activity at the San Pasqual Education Center. The San Pasqual Education Center teamed up with Mr. Crouch a retired teacher from the Valley Center School District to provide oak seedlings to attendees in efforts to restore oak trees. The San Pasqual Environmental Department handed out the Environmental Awareness Ambassadors "EWA" Activity Book which was created in collaboration with local artist Marti Daglio to highlight the EWA youth group activities for 2023.

And in attendance were organizations such as SDZWA, USFWS, USFS, GRID Alternatives, Catching H20, San Diego Living Discovery Center, La Jolla EPO, SDG&E, Escondido Creek Conservancy, Climate Science Alliance and many more that provided important resources and education. All in all it was a great day of learning for the San Pasqual tribal community.





To fit the needs of the working community and to prevent illegal dumping on the reservation the Environmental Department will be extending the Transfer Station hours throughout the summer. Extended hours have been put in place in efforts to reduce dumping that creates hazards for the community and the land. Illegal dumping is prohibited on all lands within the exterior boundaries of the reservation including at the transfer station during non-business hours. The San Pasqual Environmental Wellness Ambassadors is a tribal youth group geared towards environmental protection & the healing of tribal land. It is our goal to create awareness, inspire and empower tribal youth to be effective leaders for environmental and climate justice. This group combines traditional ecological knowledge, Kumeyaay culture (past/present) and environmental science to create a relationship between the youth and our land. Summer Activities will consist of classroom style lessons and field trips focused on Environmental Health and Culture.
